

BACTEVAG

Intimate Gel

Ingredients: Lactic acid and excipients consisting of Aqua, Propylene Glycol, Xanthan Gum, Glycerin, Sodium Levulinate, Hydroxypropyl, Methylcellulose, Sodium Lactate, Galactoarabinan, Sodium Anisate.

- Provides relief from unpleasant odor and abnormal discharge
- Quick relief of itching, burning sensations, vaginal irritation and abnormal discharge
- Treatment of bacterial vaginosis
- Optimizes the vaginal flora balance and inhibits the growth of pathogenic microorganisms

The information may have been amended in accordance with new research and findings since you opened your last package. The BACTEVAG Gel can be obtained without a prescription. Nevertheless, take care when using - BACTEVAG Gel to obtain good results. Keep these instructions to use in case you need to consult them again.

Purpose of use: BACTEVAG Gel is an auxiliary means in the treatment of bacterial vaginosis and restoring the acidity and the balance of the vaginal flora. It is an acidifying gel composed of lactic acid, which helps to reestablish the vaginal microbial environment by lowering the vaginal pH.

Instruction for use (for adults only): BACTEVAG Gel comes in hygienic single use applicators to facilitate insertion into the vagina. It is best to use - BACTEVAG Gel before bedtime when lying down. This reduces potential leakage. It may be helpful to wear a panty liner, as it is common to notice slight leakage. Use immediately after opening.

- 1. Break off and remove the end tab.
- 2. Sit or lie in a comfortable position and gently insert the neck of the applicator into the vagina as far as it will comfortably go.
- 3. Gently squeeze the applicator to release the contents.
- 4. Remove the tube while still squeezing it, and discard.

Mode of action: - BACTEVAG Gel is inserted by a single use applicator into the vagina, where it dissolves and promotes the restoration of the natural physiological intra-vaginal conditions and healthy growth of the normal bacteria. The active ingredient is lactic acid which creates an environment unfavorable to the excessive growth of potentially pathogenic bacteria and fungi and favors the establishment of an aciduric and acidogenic flora and enhances the growth of desirable bacteria by the formation of lactic acid on the fermentation of carbohydrates. Lactic acid permits pH control to within the optimal range (usually pH 4.0 - 4.5). Lactic acid contributes to vaginal acidity.

Contents: 7 vaginal tubes of 5 ml

Possible side effects: Lactic acid is safe and tolerable. Common side effects are vaginal symptoms such as itching and/or a burning sensation.

Warnings:

- For external use only.
- Do not use BACTEVAG Gel, If you are hypersensitive to one or more of the ingredients.
- Use during pregnancy and/or breastfeeding: As with any drug, if you are pregnant or nursing a baby, seek the advice of a health professional before using this product.
- Please consult your doctor or pharmacist before using this product if you are pregnant with breastfeeding.
- If you experience allergic reactions, stop using the product.
- Keep out of reach of young children.



Storage instructions: Store at room temperature (5-25°C) in a dry and dark place in the original container and out of reach of young children.



Shelf life: 36 months from the date of manufacture. The date of manufacture is contained in the serial number imprinted on the weld of the tube and is printed on the box.
